1a) 1 hour	4:00-5:00 p.m. Dedication of Crowley Lake Ball Field – The Board will meet at 4:00 p.m. at the Crowley Lake Ballfield for a dedication ceremony. Action: None. The Board gathered on the outfield of the Crowley Lake Ball field to dedicate the field (Supervisor Hunt, absent). Vice Chair Hazard was the master of ceremony. In this capacity he talked about the history of the field and introduced members of the public and past elected officials who played a key role in the development of the property.
6:45 p.m.	Meeting called to Order by Acting Chair Hazard at the Crowley Lake Community Center OPPORTUNITY FOR THE PUBLIC TO ADDRESS THE BOARD Acting Chair Hazard explained to the audience that the Board was scheduled to have rent control on the July 20 th agenda. At that meeting, the Board would discuss and act upon, if appropriate, the county's role in rent control in mobile home parks. In the meantime, staff was working on the background information in preparation for the July meeting. Since there were no agenda items including rent control, the Chair asked for public comment. Many people spoke about their concerns as renters in the mobile home park in Crowley Lake. The basic complaint was broken into three categories, increasing annual rent cost, lack of maintenance on site, and lack of service. Several people spoke about problems areas such as lack of tree maintenance, feeling taken advantage of by management, misinformation from management, and concerns about affordable housing in the areas.

Individual Board members responded at the end of the meeting saying they understood the concerns that were brought forward at the meeting. They would following up the June 15th meeting in July with a staff report and would have a better sense at that time about the County's role in rent control and the direction the Board might take relative to the Crowley Lake concerns and the County as a whole.
