OPPORTUNITY FOR THE PUBLIC TO ADDRESS THE BOARD

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS (Supervisor Hazard)

1a) Consider and discuss a letter opposing Assembly Bill 2456, which would provide the Director of the State Emergency Medical Services Authority (EMSA) with unlimited power to disallow and overturn years of local EMS Agency policies and procedures. AB 2456 would remove the flexibility critical to appropriate emergency care in rural areas and replace it with a lengthy and cumbersome process that does not improve the delivery of emergency services. The cost of the bill's implementation would be borne by local agencies and passed down to the EMS professionals via increased licensure fees.

M10-184 ACTION: Adopt and authorize the Chair's signature on a letter opposing AB 2456. **Hazard/Bauer 5-0**

Supervisor Hazard:

- Bill that's been out for awhile but is currently working through the system.
- Not a good bill from our point of view.
- Many counties sending in letters of opposition.
- Asks that we pass draft letter as-is with the ability to fill in addressees as needed.
- Once approved he'll be on the phone with the Senator's staff.
