RE: Appointment of three members to the standing six-member pool(s) of available Personnel Appeals Board members with respect to the Mono County Public Employees (MCPE) and Deputy Probation Officers (DPO) bargaining units. (Note: the other members of the pool will be appointed by the bargaining units.)

Recommendation:

Pursuant to Section 540(A) of the County Personnel System applicable to County employees whose positions are represented by the Mono County Public Employees (MCPE) and Deputy Probation Officers (DPO) bargaining units, appoint Brian Muir, Rita Sherman, and Julie Tiede as members of the six-member standing pool of available Personnel Appeals Board members with respect to each bargaining unit (i.e., the same three individuals will be available members in both pools).

Fiscal/Mandates Impact:

None.

Discussion:

Under Section 540 of the new personnel rules applicable to MCPE and DPO employees, members of the Personnel Appeals Board will be drawn from standing six-member pools (one pool for each bargaining unit). The Board of Supervisors appoints three of the six members for each pool; the bargaining unit appoints the other three. The rules provide that an individual may be appointed to serve in more than one standing pool. When a particular matter is to come before the Personnel Appeals Board, a three-person panel is selected from the pool.

The rules require that members of the pool be current County employees (a change from previous personnel rules). Members serve for a term of four years but may be removed at any time without cause.

The CAO recommends appointment of the following three county employees, all of whom are willing to serve: Rita Sherman, Brian Muir, and Julie Tiede. They would serve as available members for both the MCPE and DPO standing pools.
