



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Sierra Business Park Berms

- Height of berm varies from approximately 8' to 12'
- Width of berm approximately 57'
- Irrigation sprinklers located at top berm
- Appears to be soil that was dozed off interior of park to create the perimeter berm
- Slope appears to be slightly less than 2 to 1.
