3. **Field Trip : Main Street Stenciling**

  - a. Supervisor’s report (Tim Fesko): Mono County Budget = \$62 Million. Hired Mono County Assessor – Bob Museli (?). Mono County is starting to save for the upcoming CARB emissions standards - \$1 million in 2013/2014.
  - b. USFS update (Mike Crawley): Due to his impending retirement, special use permits will be handled by David. Forest Service law enforcement will be all new rangers. In regard to the trees that have been cut down in the Sweetwaters for Sage Grouse habitat – there is a beetle infestation and no one should take the wood.
