## Antelope Valley RPAC Minutes November 2, 2017, 6:30 pm Antelope Valley Community Center

Members present: Anthony x 2, Brown, Buell, Christensen, Gerbig, Langner, Mosby. Agencies present: Peters/Supervisor, Le Francois/Planning, Power/USMC. 9 community members attended.

Approve of October 5, 2017 minutes: Motion to approve (Christensen/Anthony) passed.

Public comment: Burn permits, fire extinguisher recalls and the Women's Club Bazaar were discussed.

Informational/Discussion or Action Items:

MWTC update: Doug Power discussed base activities. Buell and Langner commented on the negative visual impact of the new antenna facility at base housing.

Supervisor's Report: John Peters discussed recent tourism/senior/fisheries meetings, the completion of work on 395 in the valley, senior center lighting, the pavement management plan, proposed NPS fee increases, and a possible January town hall meeting in Walker.

Update on Antelope Valley Community Center campus improvements: Christensen reported that she met with Supervisor Peters and turned over a list of projects to Le Francois for forwarding to the project review committee.

Discuss and consider a letter of support for Antelope Valley Cannabis Association to the Board of Supervisors: Peters distributed and discussed a Mono Co. Cannabis Regulations FAQ sheet; he said it is a very complex issue. Group discussion included a letter concerning support of a pilot program, taxation, illegal and unregulated growing, the adoption of state regulations, a moratorium extension and other topics. Le Francois will draft a letter for the RPAC to the BOS concerning RPAC support for expedited action to allow the cultivation of cannabis in Antelope Valley.

Discuss and clarify language of the Mixed Use Land Use Designation in the Antelope Valley: Le Francois discussed. Motion (Christensen/Mosby) to support adoption of changes to MU language passed (7 yes/1 no).

Discuss RPAC officers for 2018: Mosby will look for a new student member as that position is currently open.
