

Antelope Valley RPAC Meeting minutes

2. Receive presentation on Accessory Dwelling Unit Prescriptive Designs from Bentley Regehr. County has funding for four designs but we have 5 to consider. Group discussion. Agreed that we like all five designs and would ask the County to consider funding all five. Didn't catch who made the motion or second. Voting unanimous to have County fund all five if possible.

MMWTC: SGM. Doug Powers: Currently conducting 3rd Core Battalion training with ~1500 people on base. Maring Corp is restructuring to a leaner, more mission focused entity.

HTUSFS: David Risley Acting District Ranger for 120 days.
