Letter from Irene Mandelbaum

Dear Members of the Board,

I understand that a Mono County Recreation staff position is being considered as part of the Budget for the 2018 fiscal year.

I recognize that there is a serious gap in the provision of recreation management and infrastructure in Mono County due to in large part to the drastically reduced budget for federal lands in Mono County.

My recommendation is that the job description and qualifications for such a position emphasize environmental resource management, not just recreation, with objectives that direct pro-active work to ensure a sustainable environment. In this way, Mono County involvement with recreational infrastructure and visitor activities, land management (such as Conway Ranch), energy development, etc. would be balanced with the essential guidance that the protection of the natural environment is carefully considered. I would like to see such a position include a focus on bringing the broader expertise and financial resources that are needed to match the increasing pressures on our natural surroundings.

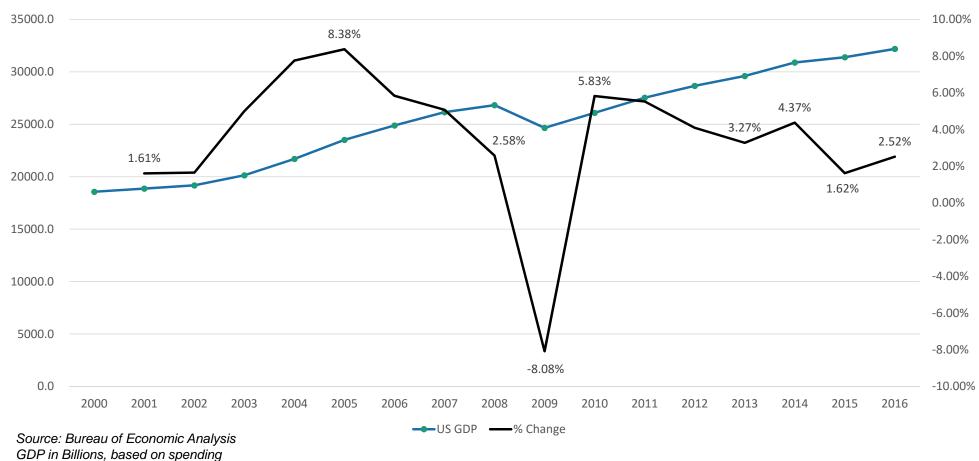

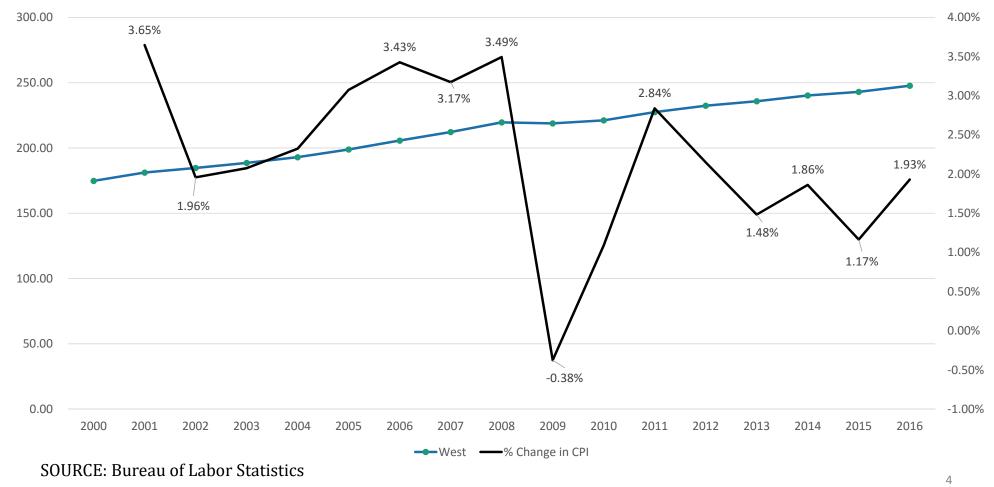




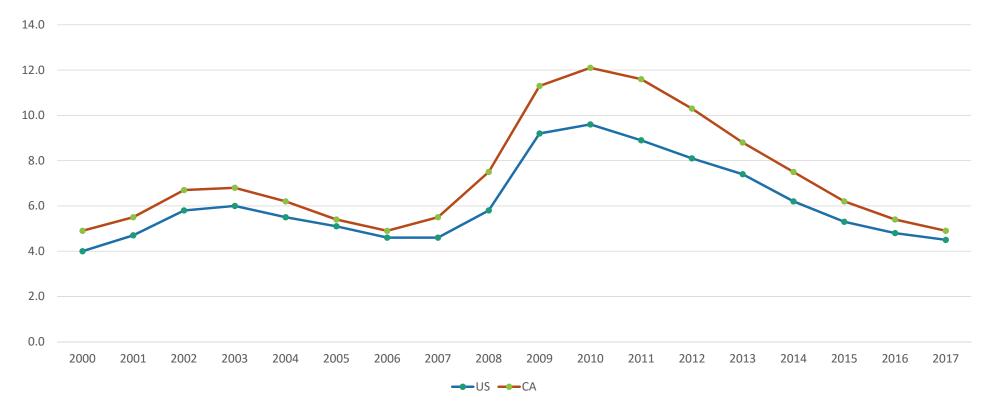
GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT

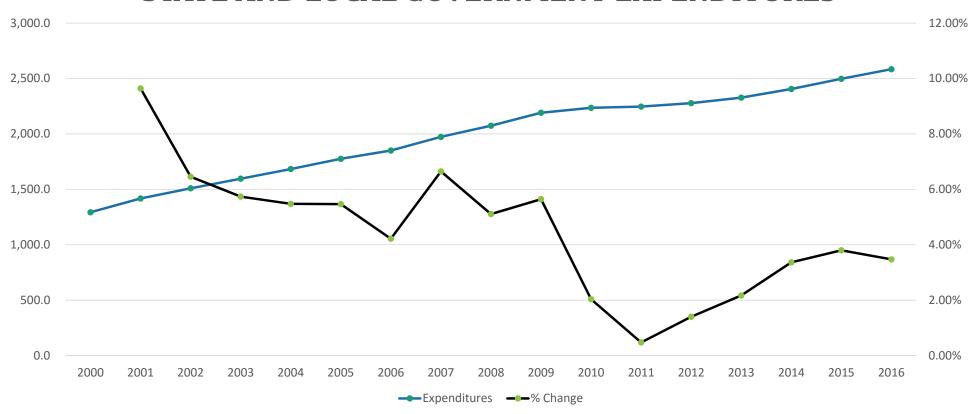
CONSUMER PRICE INDEX

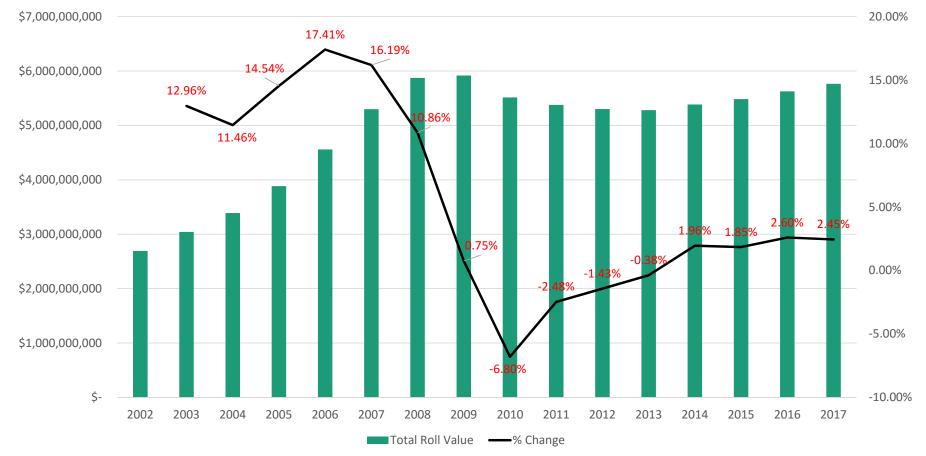


STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT EXPENDITURES

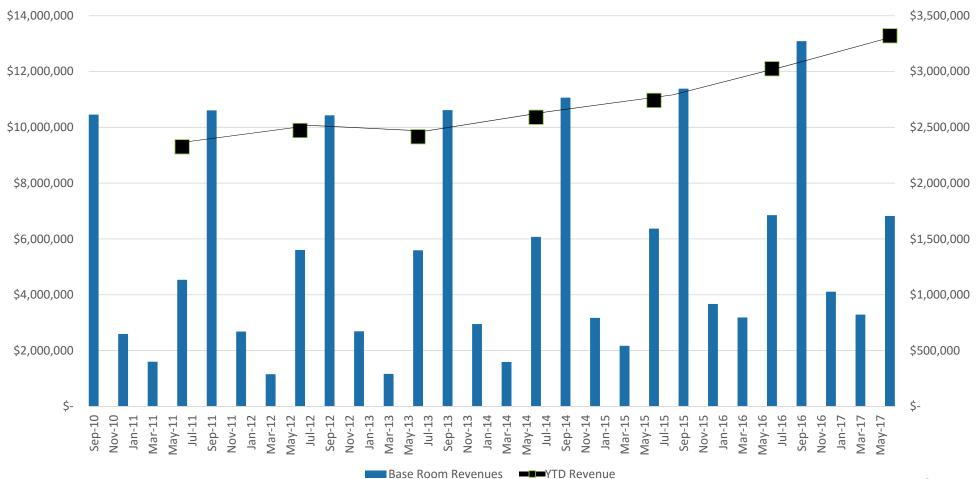
MONO COUNTY - Local Economy

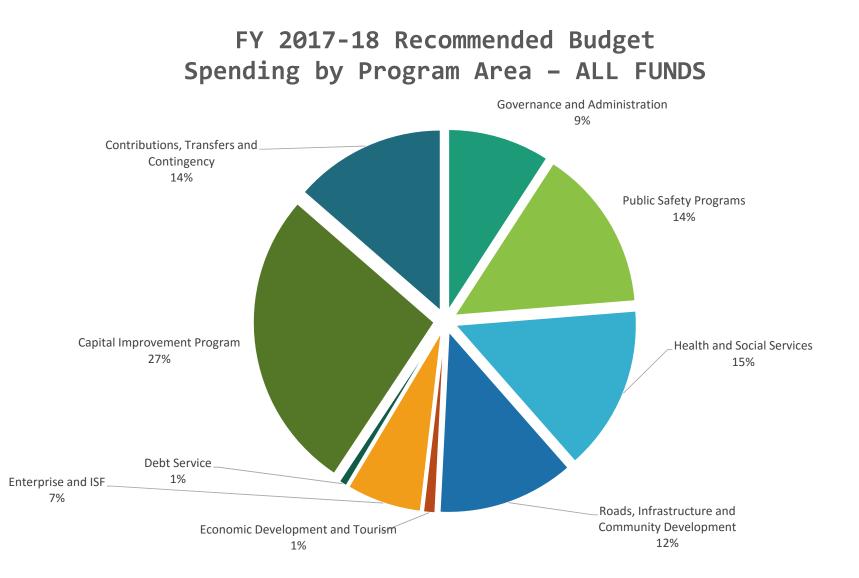

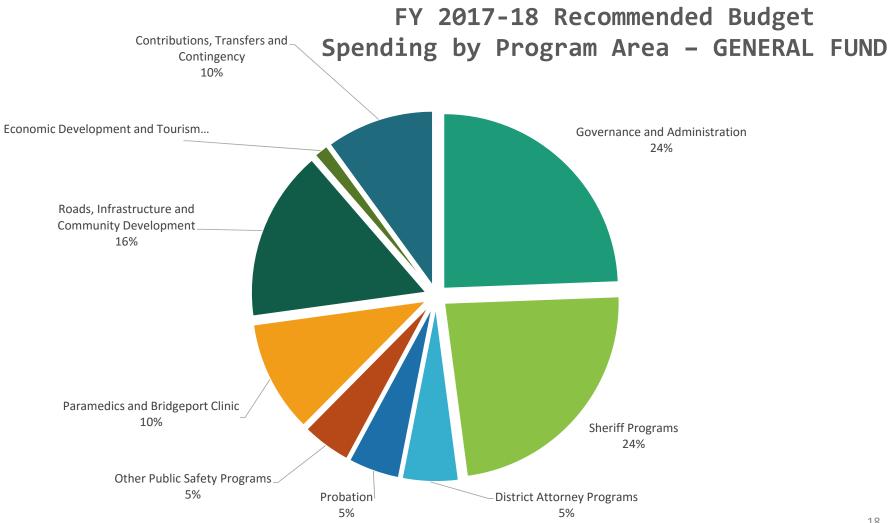

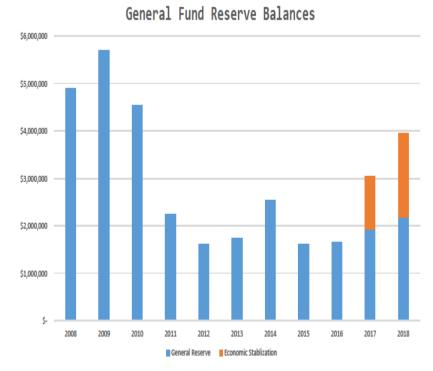
