What does Early Stage 2 mean?

The State of California lays out multiple phases of Stage 2 to be gradually implemented based on the readiness of a county. The state may certify some counties to qualify to move on to Expanded Stage 2 faster if they are able to show greater progress. Counties that have met the criteria and filed an Attestation are listed **here**.
