

LCK LOCAL FIRE REGULATIONS

d use pro campfire skills! If campfires are allowed, get a mandatory permit at readyforwildfire.org.

Never leave your fire unattended make sure it's completely out. Just e.mber can start a wild fire!

- PACK IT OUT! Take all trash including food scraps, toilet paper, and pet waste.
- POO LIKE A PRO. Set up your Poo Zone 200 feet from your camp and water sources.

Bury your waste 6" down or use 'wag bags' or a portable toilet. Pack out all used toilet paper.
