The project would allow placement of three overhead power-poles in the County right-of-way for 3858 Crowley Lake Drive (APN 060-150-004) in Crowley Lake. The utility line will then be undergrounded through an existing easement and across the property to the primary structure. The parcel is approximately 1.04-acres in size, is designated Single-Family Residential (SFR), and contains a residence and shed. A California Environmental Quality Assessment (CEQA) exemption is proposed.
