Mono County Seeks Feedback on Local Priorities

Residents Encouraged to Participate in Strategic Plan Community Survey

MONO COUNTY, Calif. (DECEMBER 15, 2021) – Mono County is currently updating its Strategic Plan, and seeking input from residents and stakeholders to guide the process. The Strategic Plan is rooted in the organization’s Mission, Vision, and Values – the underpinnings which describe why and how the county does what it does. The goal of the update is to further align local governmental priorities with overarching initiatives that guide the tactical work efforts of each department.

“We encourage everyone who has a stake in Mono County to participate in this important survey,” stated Jennifer Kreitz, Chair of the Mono County Board of Supervisors. “Your input is extremely valued, and as public servants we want to ensure that our efforts are aligned with the appropriate priorities as identified by our residents and stakeholders.”

Mono County has released a digital community survey to solicit input from residents and stakeholders to identify their top county government priorities. The brief community survey consists of five questions, and will be open for participation through January 28, 2022.
