Mono County is a destination that is full of opportunity and adventure. Set on the eastern slope of California's Sierra Nevada mountain range, Mono County is a rare environment of natural contrasts: soaring granite peaks, spacious desert vistas, serene lakes and cold mountain streams, deep winter snows and sunny summer skies.

With a year-round population of roughly 14,000 spread over 3,000mi.² of geography, we are considered a frontier county. The County seat is located in Bridgeport - situated 350 miles north of Los Angeles and 120 miles south of Reno. JOB DESCRIPTION

Under general supervision, assist with the development and maintenance of core GIS functionality and datasets, develop on a limited basis, deploy, and maintain web-based GIS services, maps, and tools, provide support to GIS staff and other end-users, provide insight and recommendations regarding 'Best Practice' uses of GIS, and perform other duties as assigned.

- Publishing & maintaining web services using the ArcGIS platform (GIS Specialist I)

- Effective utilization of GIS for common business practices
- Experience using Esri mobile apps for visualizing and collecting data in the field
- Creating, maintaining, & improving interactive web maps published using Esri's web GIS platform
- Managing web GIS access, privileges, and other settings
- Scripting for GIS using Python and ArcPy for ArcGIS (especially for GIS Specialist I)
- (Some knowledge of) Administering Windows servers and GIS server-based software (GIS Specialist I)

EDUCATION AND/OR EXPERIENCE

Recent Masters, Bachelor or Associate Degree, or a similar certificate, in a field with formal GIS training as part of its curriculum, AND two (2) years of experience working with the technology referenced herein; or

A minimum of three (3) years of experience working in a lower-level position with the ability to demonstrate advanced editing and data management skills, as well as knowledge of web GIS technology; and

To be considered for GIS Specialist I, candidate should have three (3) years of experience working as a GIS Analyst (or similar) and/or must hold a degree versus a certificate to obtain satisfactory education/experience.

A combination of experience or education is a completely satisfactory method of acquiring the technical skills and knowledge.

APPLICATION AND EXAM PROCESS

Applications will be competitively reviewed, and qualified candidates will be invited to participate in a recruitment process consisting of an oral interview and a computer-based practical exam. A screening call may be scheduled.

Special Requirements: Satisfactory completion of a Department of Justice Background investigation. Possession of a valid Driver's License. May work other than a normal 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. shift.
