Dear Ms. Brown:

Thank you for the recent feedback on behalf of the June Lake Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) regarding traffic along State Route (SR) 158. We plan to continue open communication with the CAC as we complete a maintenance order for the installation of crosswalk pavement markings and supporting signage at Knoll Road, and new bus stop signage for three locations along SR 158.

As requested by the CAC, Caltrans will begin working on a project proposal for the installation of two to four new curb ramps within the community of June Lake. Once the proposal is complete and approved, we will present the information to the CAC for further input prior to programming the project for funding. Given concerns about parking, please be aware that the installation of new curb ramps will remove two to four parking spots per crossing location. The removal of parking is required to provide clear sight lines for crossing pedestrians, bicyclists, and motorists. The total number of parking spots reduced will be identified during the design phase of the project.

Caltrans will continue our review of the entire route to identify locations for possible future improvements and enhancements.
