

SCE Mammoth Lakes Storage Area One

As part of SCE's wildfire mitigation plan, inspections in critical fire areas have been performed to identify necessary system repairs and upgrades. SCE's Mammoth Lakes Storage Area One at 164 Industrial Circle in Mammoth Lakes, will act as material storage and contractor show up yards for crews making the repairs and upgrades identified as part of the inspection process.

Storage Area One

Storage Area One is a cleared and mostly level area within an existing industrial park. Earthen berms border the north and east sides of the yard, an existing block wall to the west and a chain link fence to the south.

The yard will operate from 6 am to 6 pm, or from sunrise to sunset, depending on the time of year. Storage Area One will act as a material storage yard for poles, composite arms, frames, insulators and other materials required to complete upgrades and repairs of the existing electrical system. A mobile security guard will be onsite during non-working hours.

Portable restrooms, serviced by an authorized service provider at regular intervals, will be maintained on site. Trash receptacles and recycling bins will be maintained on site and serviced by an authorized service provider.

Dust control will be provided by water trucks on an as needed basis. Operation of the site will be consistent with surrounding uses and is not anticipated to generate potential nuisances.

The impermeable parking BMP will be inspected on a monthly basis by the Yard's Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) inspector to verify the integrity of the system and recommend repairs and changes as necessary.

Wind Blown Debris Mitigation



The following BMP's will be implemented to prevent debris from crossing property lines:

- Monthly walk-through inspection of the yard to confirm compliance with permits and/or environmental guidelines
- Materials/tools will have properly fitted lids or some other type of covering where necessary
- Lightweight, loose or stockpiled materials will be stored inside, pending availability of connex containers, or under appropriate cover
- Trash or other debris will be disposed of in appropriate containers to avoid pile up and decreasing change of windblown litter

*Project component placement and dimensions are approximate.



