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June 10, 2026 Mono Basin RPAC Minutes:

1. Call to Order 6:32p
2. Public Comment- NA
3. Information:
 - a. Caltrans LV rehab update- rescoped project bid accepted application to award. The retention basin outside corridor drainage for storm water will remain undisturbed. Tree species will include red maple replacements. Continuing coordination with the LVPUD.
 - b. Update on MMP grant for LV rehab- LTC-RTP-Mono Basin plan. (ATP Cycle 8 handout)- award would provide gap funding for missing elements from the Caltrans rescoped project. Enhancements would include pedestrian scale lighting, flashing beacons, RRFBs, school safe multi-use path through Gus Hess park, and multi-modal placemaking including a transit shelter and benches.
 - c. Updated Mono County RPAC policies and procedures- RPACs remain a place for individual discussion without approval authority to provide a community forum planning projects, but to help provide community feedback to area policies. The scope of community interest could vary by departments, and CDD will develop and implement strategies to provide these resources.

 - b. USFS- July horse round-up is scheduled. A two week round-up of 450 horses with removal to an Oregon holding facility. MLC was able to fix projector for Visitor Center.
 - c. Supervisor McFarland- Commissioner vacancies for special district elections and governing boards. Developed recreation, FOI TA, Housing analyst Patricia Robertson quickly moving with future visit, LV Comm. Center housing survey is ongoing for site plan. GPA of land designation for MFH. Mono City Firewise community gathering in Mono City. Land exchange BLM ie BP roadshop, Mono City Fire Station public benefit.

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- d. Chair- Lee Vining Women's League was able to provide (2) local scholarships, with hopes to improve fundraising through their website. Local dinner fundraiser at the Chautauqua.
- e. Member reports- Mono City fire-wise, MLC partner training, State H2O workshop, Avian resources, Boardwalk grant funding
- f. Firesafe council- Mono city community gathering thanks to Connie, Lisa, and Margaret. Presentations included Supe. McFarland, SCE, CDFW, and MCFPD and discussion on grants for green waste dumpster, wildland equipment, garage and permitting, generators, and secondary egress improvements.
