**1. Opportunity for the Public to Address the Board**

**2. Five Year Strategic Plan Update – 20 minutes**

James Hayes of Sage Business & Education, LLC provided an overview of the Mono County Strategic Plan Outline.

- Data tracking and accountability was a concern. James explained that this strategic plan will have an accountability tool attached to the plan and a recommendation that updates be provided to the CCP regularly.
- Patricia Robertson had a concern about the burden falling solely on Probation.
- Next steps: receive comments and suggestions to the strategic plan for April meeting so Executive Committee can vote and approve it.
- Jazmin to send the live link to the report to the committee.

**3. FY 2025-2026 Budget Review – 5 minutes**

Kasandra, Probation's FASO, provided an overview of the FY 2025-2026 revenues, expenditures, and the current fund balance.

- It was recommended that Kasandra not only read off the amounts, but to provide a visual of what the funding is supporting.

**4. CCP Member Updates – Roundtable – 10 minutes**

**5. Transition to CCP Executive Committee**

Transition was announced, some committee members stayed for the Executive Committee discussion.

**6. Executive Committee Minutes – 5 minutes**

Minutes were approved.

**7. FY 2026-2027 Budget Planning and Funding Priorities – 15-20 minutes**

- Members requested clarification of the funding parameters. Probation Chair, Jazmin, explained the purpose of AB109 funding.
- Amanda Greenberg discussed possibly asking the CCP to support a residential treatment center in Bishop, like the Elms Motel. DA Anderson requested that if CCP approved the funding, in return a guaranteed bed would be available for our clients.
- Chief Casabian expressed his intend to submit a proposal for body cameras through Axon that have translation capabilities. Members wanted someone other than MLPD officers to show how it functions. Jazmin volunteered to provide a video of the camera using the translation service.
