Traumatic Stress Institute and Molly DesBaillets to present program and proposal for funding. Discussion whether the program meets JJCC criteria and if it should be funded and supported by the JJCC.

- 7. FY 2026-2027 Funding Proposal: Public Defender Training Requirements**

- 8. Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act & Youthful Offender Block Grant (JJCPS-YOBG) 2025-2026 Consolidated Annual Plan and Juvenile Justice Realignment Block Grant SB 823**
JJCC to review 2026-2027 plans and determine if any changes need to be made. Reports are due May 1, 2026.

Recommended Action: Review, discuss, and approve the 2026-2027 JJCPA/YOBG Consolidated Annual Plan and SB 823 Plan for submission to the State.
