



Self-Identified Race/Ethnicity






It is critical to start sex education interventions in middle school

Age of First Sex (oral, vaginal, or anal) by Region




Mean age of first sex among those sexually active = 14.74


Local teens are sexting



Increase focus on access to services




Increase focus on racial/ethnic disparities




Normalize STD conversation & testing

Have you or your partners ever been tested for STDs?




Did you know that sexually active teens should be tested annually for STDs?



Raise awareness of LARC**




The last time you had vaginal sex, what birth control methods did you or your partner use to prevent pregnancy?

Limit number of partners




Mean number of partners (oral, vaginal, anal sex) among those sexually active = 2.67


Drug Use & Intensity of Use

Have you ever used any of the following substances?





How much do you usually use the following?




Intent to Use & Perceived Risk

In the next 12 months how likely are you to use the following?




How dangerous is it to use the following regularly?




Access to Drugs & Alcohol
