1. April 7, 2016 meeting minutes approved as amended.
2. Public comment: Mike Curti said that defensible space dump coupons are available at the fire station.
3. Doug Power (MWTC) reported that there will be a change of command at the base in July.
4. Supervisor Fesko reported that the county is assisting in opening Highway 120, that a MOU with local agencies was created to assist in getting Mill Canyon Road open for agency and public use and that repaving work on Highway 395 through Antelope Valley will continue through the summer.
5. Jake Suppa (jsuppa@mon.ca.gov) presented a presentation on the Sustainable Agriculture Land Conservation grant.
6. Anthony/Anthony made and withdrew two motions before making the motion "I move that RPAC endorse the use of FEMA/County properties on N. River Road and Meadow Lane as open space, without development for public improvements and facilities, and added to the area plan and, therefore, the general plan, for a term of at least 25 yrs." After discussion by the RPAC and community the motion was passed 10 for/0 opposed.
7. Buell/Curti made a motion to adopt the AVRPAC by-laws as recently revised. Motion passed 10 for/0 opposed.
