Meeting Minutes August 2, 2016

The meeting was called to order at 7:01 PM by Jeff Ronci. Committee members present Jil Stark, Bob Gardner and Patti Heinrich. Scott Burns, Nick Criss. Tim Alpers was also in attendance.

Review and approval of Minutes June 7, and July 5, 2016: Motion to approve the June 7, minutes was made by Jil and seconded by Patti, passed unanimously. A motion was made to approve the July 5 minutes was made by Jil and passed unanimously.

Public Comment:

Sara Welch, June Lake Women's Club showed the new map of June Lake, that the Women's Club had made and the original art work that will be auctions off at a later date.

Joe Blommer, Caltrans, gave an update of the ongoing project, rock mesh and the guard rails by the fire area.

Kirstie Butler, USFS, brief the results of the Chipper Weekend.

Patti Heinrich, announced the Annual Historical Society Meeting Thursday night at 6:30 pm.

Al Heinrich asked Supervisor what was the status of the moss and weeds in Gull Lake and asked to have it put on the agenda.

Agenda Items:

Supervisor Tim Alpers report: Tim explained the June Lake Community Center Improvement Funds and that contributions can be made to the Mono County indicating June Lake Community Center Improvement Fund and mailed to Leslie Chapman PO Box 696, Bridgeport, CA 93517. Community Center windows will be replaced under the regular budget items. Patti stated that the women's club to date has spent \$181,106.19 on the community, not including the cost of the building.

June Lake Trails Committee report: (Jil Stark): Discussed the trails with in the June Lake Loop and stated that the majority of the trail fall on USFS land. The committee area of concern is the Petersen Tract.

Review of proposed revision to TROD: Many members of the community were in attendance and voiced their concerns regarding the personal effect of the changes and the TROD creating the neighbor against neighbor. It appears that the majority are not in favor of TROD specially in the Williams, Petersen and Clark Tracts. After much discussion the committee asked staff to revise the June Area Plan wording to exempt certain areas within the June Lake Loop from TROD consideration.
