



Department of Motor Vehicles Request for Driving Records



Hello Resource Family Applicant,

As part of the application process for Resource Family Approval (RFA), we are required to review DMV records for all adults that will be driving children in their vehicles. The intention behind this is to be sure that caregivers do not have histories of unsafe driving. If a DMV record shows any history, we need to review it and determine if those driving patterns have been resolved.

There are two ways you can get your DMV record(s): The first would be to physically go to a California DMV office and request a copy of your records. If you are not close to a California DMV office than the easier option is to make the request on-line using the following link:

When you get to this website, you'll have the choice to request your Online Driver Record. (You *do not need* to order "official" reports unless you choose to). You'll need to click the "Start" prompt to become a certified user. If you do not already have a user account click the "Register" prompts and it should take you through the registration process. Please let us know if you run into any issues.

The cost for your printed unofficial DMV record(s) is \$2.00 each. Please print the receipt as well and we will reimburse you.

** If you think that other drivers in the household will be routinely driving foster children, then we will need their DMV record as well.
