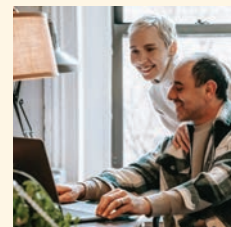

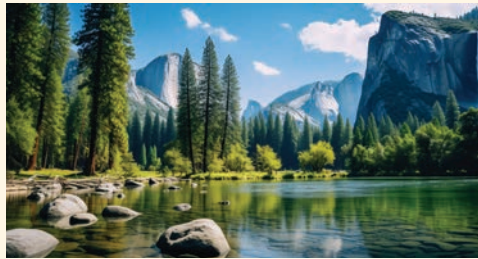
FREE Bus Travel to Yosemite
